Zīmēšanas papīrs, zīmulis, dzēšgumija.	<p><b>Proportions of the Face</b></p> <p>To begin drawing a portrait you will first need to draw an egg shape. Remember that the narrow part of the egg points down as this will become the chin.</p> <p>Draw a line vertically right through the centre of the egg. This line will make sure that you line up the nose, mouth and eyes correctly.</p> <p>Draw a horizontal line half way down the egg. This is where the eyes and top of the nose will go.</p> <p>Half way between the eye line and the chin draw a second horizontal line. This is where the bottom of the nose and ears will go.</p> <p>A third of the way down from the nose line draw a third horizontal line. This is where the mouth will go.</p> <p>Draw in the eyes with the corners on the line. To ensure the eyes are the correct size you should be able to fit five equal eye widths across.</p> <p>Draw the bottom of the nose. The nostrils should rest on the line.</p> <p>Draw in the mouth with the line dividing the two lips. By measuring a third in from the middle corner of the eye and drawing a line vertically on each side, you can achieve an accurate mouth width.</p> <p>Draw in the ears and the hairline. The hairline can help determine the shape of the face. Remember the ears should fit snugly between the eye and nose lines.</p> <p>Draw the neck by drawing a vertical line from the outer corner of the eye on each side to achieve the correct width.</p> <p>Proportions of the Face Information Sheet</p> <p>Ray Shree's Head Drawing &amp; Hair Portraits</p>
